



BRITISH ADVANCED LEVEL

Period : June 2024 – June 2026

Ladies' College is an approved school for the above course of study. We have been preparing students for the British Advanced Level examination for the last four decades. In the recent past, some of our students have reached great heights, scoring the highest grades in the island and the world in their respective subjects.

Unlike the Local Advanced Level where the students sit for one examination at the end of their course of study, the British Advanced Level subjects are split into units and their respective examinations can be taken within the period of two years.

Our school offers the students a choice of two examination boards; Science, Mathematics and Commerce subjects are in the Edexcel Board and most of the Arts & Humanities subjects are in the Cambridge Board.

The first year is known as the "Advanced Subsidiary (AS) Level" and the second year is the "Advanced (A2) Level". Mathematics and Science subjects consist of 3 units in each year, whereas Economics, Business Studies, Literature in English, Sociology, Psychology, Media Studies and Geography have two units each year. Accounting has one unit each year and Art & Design and Law is to be taken up once, at the end of the course.

The following is the combination of subjects currently available at Ladies' College. The students have to choose only one subject from each of the baskets given below. We allow your daughter to choose from two options in completing their Advanced Level at Ladies' College.
